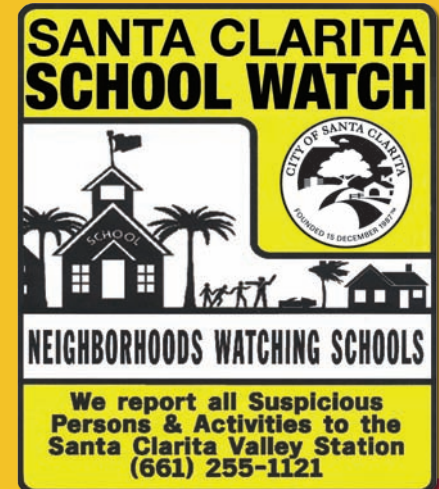

START A SANTA CLARITA SCHOOL WATCH IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD

The SANTA CLARITA SCHOOL WATCH PROGRAM is one of the most effective and least costly ways to reduce and prevent crime on school grounds. It also creates a working partnership between the school, the community, and law enforcement.

SCHOOL WATCH GROUPS are extra eyes and ears for reporting suspicious activity that may occur on or near a school campus, including:

- Anyone marking school property with graffiti
- Anyone breaking into the office or classrooms
- Unsupervised children playing on school grounds when the school is closed
- Vandals or skateboarders on the campus causing damage to the school
