March is Traffic Safety Awareness Month in the City of Santa Clarita!

Did you Know...?

- When approached by an emergency vehicle sounding its siren and displaying a red light, all vehicular traffic shall yield the right of way, safely drive to the right side of the roadway and stop. This includes all vehicles, even if the roadway is separated by a center median or island.
- Beginning July 1st, 2008, it will be illegal for any person under the age of 18 to use a wireless telephone while driving a motor vehicle. This also includes phones equipped with hands-free devices. Those over age 18 will be required to use a hands-free listening and talking device.
- The City of Santa Clarita participates in the Sheriff's Teen Traffic Offender Program (STTOP) and any community member can anonymously report dangerous teen drivers by calling 877-310-STOP (877-310-7867) or visit us on-line. Learn more about the program at www.SCVSheriff.com.
- Teenage drivers with a Provisional Driver's License are not allowed to drive between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.
- Any motor vehicle impounded in connection with a speed contest or reckless driving may be held for thirty days.
- Deputies issue more citations for speeding in the City of Santa Clarita than any other moving violation. *Don't be one of them!*
